Introduction

Prince Albert Frederick Arthur George, Duke of York, second son of King George V and Queen Mary, unexpectedly succeeded to the throne when his elder brother King Edward VIII abdicated on December 11th 1936. His Coronation took place on May 12th 1937 - the date set aside for Edward's Coronation, at Westminster Abbey.

The Stamps

On January 6th 1937 approval was given for a set of 3 stamps to commemorate the event. The High Commissioner in London was instructed to approach Bradbury Wilkinson & Co. regarding design and production, suggesting that they be based on the 1935 Jubilee

Approved photographs were obtained and a die cut, from which a printing was made in blue. A frame for the 2 1/2d. stamp was then hand-drawn with pen and ink to show the general effect. This was approved and steel dies for each value were then completed.















The only recognised flaw in the issue. An orange dot to the right of the 6d. in the top right hand corner.
